

## **Foundation Training Job Description**

Grade	F1
Placement	General Adult Inpatients, Psychiatry
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	All work will be under specialist supervision on the ward with support from core trainees in psychiatry, specialist grade doctors, and the full time Consultant (Clinical Supervisor). The F1 will be involved with all aspects of assessment and management of patients admitted to the ward, including physical health investigations, day to day physical and mental health needs including history taking, mental state examination, relevant investigations, participating in care review (multi-disciplinary team) meetings, liaising with other psychiatric specialties, and making accurate documentation in clinical notes.  Learning opportunities: Gaining knowledge and experience in assessing, diagnosing and managing patients with acute and common mental health problems. There is an active academic programme as well as their own Foundation programme. Opportunities to gain experience in psychotherapy (currently a Balint group). Opportunities to perform specific physical health-related skills such as venepuncture, ECGs, etc.

Main duties of the placement	Assess and manage the mental and physical health needs of inpatients at the Oakwell Centre (under supervision where appropriate).
