Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Mr Martin Wickham, Mr Naeem Siddiqui and Mr Michael Nussbaumer
Main duties of the placement	Main responsibilities are to the patients on the wards (non-elective and post-op), in the emergency clinics and in the Emergency Department.
Typical working pattern in this placement	 Daily ward rounds and ward work. Regular emergency clinics and daytime on calls throughout the week, shared with two other junior doctors. Paediatric pre-assessment clinic once a week – usually 1:3 with the two other junior doctors. Approximately 1:5 weekday evening on calls, shared with the two other junior doctors and the two SpRs. Daytime or evening shifts on Saturdays/Sundays in Sheffield – approximately 1:3
