To improve communication skills with patients, relatives and colleagues. To develop skills in managing time and conflicting priorities. At the end of the four month period the FY2 will have obtained experience in the following: Diagnosing a wide range of common conditions Treatment of a wide range of common conditions Management of a wide range of common conditions Trainees will be given audit topics to prepare at the start of their work in the department.
