Department	<p>The hospital unit is busy service giving wide experience in acute general paediatrics, surgery, ENT, dermatology, orthopaedic and dental children. There are ten Special Care baby cots with intensive care facilities for two and a half cots and one high dependency cot.</p> <p>Out-Patients work is shared between Consultants, but is also supported by junior staff as a useful area to develop paediatrics experience. There are special clinics organised for children with chest problems, diabetes, cardiology, neurological problems and handicap. Visiting Consultants support clinics in paediatric cardiology, endocrinology, genetic advice and dysmorphology, cystic fibrosis, paediatrics neurology and surgery.</p>
