The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The F2's primary duties are to ward work with attendance in elective, training and emergency theatres.
	The appointee will be responsible for the admission procedure of orthopaedic patients and emergency admissions. The F2 will be required to attend outpatient clinics and to assist in operating per duty roster.
	Responsible for admissions, pre-operative assessment and examination and initiation of treatment under the supervision of the Consultants. Continuing management of patients when on call. Assisting in ophthalmic clinics. Assisting in operating theatres when required and performing procedures as delegated by the Consultants. Regular specialty teaching.

Main duties of the placement	Out of hours for surgical specialities as per rota, Day to day inpatient care
