

## **Foundation Training Job Description**

Grade	F1
Placement	General Psychiatry
Department	There are 3 Acute inpatient wards at ACMH; a female ward, and male wards, each of about 23 beds. Additionally, there is an 8 bed Psychiatric Intensive Care Unit.
	The FY1 doctors will work with a single consultant psychiatrist involved in the care of their patients on the male and female wards and receive Clinical supervision from that Consultant Psychiatrist.
	There will be considerable opportunity to integrate into the inpatient MDT, which will include other Psychiatric Trainees of all levels, Inpatient Mental Health Nurses, Occupational Therapists, and Psychologists. They will gain exposure to a wide range of psychiatric presentations, and will be fully involved in the admission process/and gain experience in psychiatric history taking/Mental state examination/Risk. They will be encouraged to participate in delivering basic psychological therapies and gain experience of the use of psychotropic medication.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Trainees will take part in Trust Induction at the start of their placement, which includes mandatory training, as well as knowledge of the Trust's Electronic Patient record system, and will be expected to diligently do clinical documentation.
	Trainees are expected to attend both their Foundation School teaching as well as our in house teaching held on Wednesday afternoons (protected time), and meet with their Educational Supervisors not less than 1 hour weekly. There is ample opportunity to take part in Audit for the motivated Trainee, as well as have Sampler sessions in other Specialities in the Mental Health Trust (based on discussion with Clinical Supervisor and Service commitments).
