Placement	Gastroenterology
Department	Gastroenterology department includes inpatients, outpatients, endoscopy services and other specialised services. Our inpatients are based on ward 6 (with renal and rheumatology inpatients). We also have gastroenterology patients who require joint care with the surgeons on the surgical wards. There is a busy Endoscopy Unit offering all endoscopic procedures including ERCP, EUS and EMR

The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Experience on the wards, particularly ascitic taps and ascitic drains, and general medical procedures. Weekly mandatory FY1 teaching, weekly radiology meeting, weekly grand rounds, weekly gastro meeting (journal club, case presentations), twice monthly pathology meetings, MDTs
Where the placement is based	Ward 3, 29 & 30
Main duties of the placement	General clerking duties on wards, daily review of inpatients and documentation in notes, consultant ward rounds, organisation of tests and chasing of results, communication with relatives and members of the MDT. Discharge summaries.
Typical working pattern in this placement	There will be appropriate exposure to acute work / out of hours work. Specific rota details can be obtained from individual Trusts once posts have been allocated to individuals.
