

Foundation Training Job Description

Grade	F1
Placement	Paediatrics
Department	General paediatric department in a busy Teaching Hospital with large local ethnic population. There are 2 acute Medical wards and 1 Surgical ward based at the BRI. An acute admissions unit and observation area are based on one of the medical wards. Outpatient clinics are run at St Luke's Hospital and the FY1 trainee will be encouraged to attend clinics during their placement. Daily ward rounds are led by the Consultant team, supported by the Registrars. The junior staff will be responsible for the day to day running of the ward.
	Staffing: 2 x FY1 trainee, 1 x FY2 and 7 junior ST trainees make up the first on-call rota 8 x senior ST trainees make up the second on-call rota. Consultant of the week will work alongside the junior staff and Consultant cover will be provided out of hours
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	FY1 Weekly mandatory Teaching (Wednesday Lunchtime) X-ray meeting (Thursday Lunchtime) Departmental teaching (Friday pm) The generic skills programme comprises 6 days (including 2 in shadowing) and is delivered in conjunction with trainees from Airedale and Calderdale & Huddersfield. The FY1 trainees will have an Educational and Clinical Supervisor for their placement.
Main duties of the placement	Ward based duties – responsible for smooth running of wards. Jobs will be allocated on & following the daily ward rounds including blood taking, imaging requests, discharge letters and liaising with other departments. The foundation trainee will be supported at all times by senior staff
Typical working pattern in this placement	Late shifts until 9:30pm Weekend shifts No night shifts
