

## **Foundation Training Job Description**

Grade	F1
Placement	Geriatric Medicine
Department	The department offers excellent training opportunities in acute general medicine. On average there are 20-40 emergency admissions each day, plus Ambulatory Unit presentations. Consultants undertake post take ward rounds each day. All the major specialties have consultant cover. The facilities include a stroke/rehab unit, SSU, CCU, HDU and ITU beds as well as CT, MRI, coronary angiography, pacemaker fitting and endoscopy / bronchoscopy services.
	We have a busy Medical Assessment Unit assessing all acute medical admissions to the hospital, which provides excellent opportunity to gain experience in acute medicine. There are specialist nurse teams for cardiology, respiratory medicine and cancer.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	In addition to the Generic Skills Programme there is mandatory F1 teaching session each Wednesday. There is also weekly Departmental Teaching and teaching clinics and ward rounds. There is also a monthly rolling audit programme.
