Placement	Trauma and Orthopaedics
Department	The department provides trauma care at the Huddersfield Royal Infirmary (HRI) site and elective care at the Calderdale (CRH) site. Day care surgery is provided at both sites. Clinics both elective, fracture and trauma are held by all consultants across both sites.
	The F1 trainees are based at HRI so that they can get a good exposure to trauma and emergency management and care. This would give them adequate insight into the discipline of orthopaedics to enable them to decide for or against orthopaedics as a career.
	The trainee is also timetabled to attend a day at CRH for exposure to elective orthopaedics.
	The timetable allows a holistic exposure to Orthopaedics.
	17 x Consultants, 9 x SpR, 3 x ST1/2, 2 x FY1s, 2 x FY2s, 11 x Trust/Specialty
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	In addition to the Generic Skills Programme there is mandatory F1 teaching session each Wednesday. There is also a daily Trauma Meeting, weekly Departmental Teaching and teaching clinics and ward rounds. There is also a monthly rolling audit programme.
Where the placement is based	Calderdale Royal Hospital Huddersfield Royal Infirmary
Main duties of the placement	 Day to day management of patients under consultant care. Clerking of patients admitted to the team. Regular attendance at ward rounds held by consultant and registrar. The cover of colleagues on annual leave and short-term sickness. Any other duties commensurate with the grade which may be allocated from time to time.
Typical working pattern in this placement	There is no out of hours commitment with this placement.
