

## **Foundation Training Job Description**

Dermatology and General Medicine (2 months spent in Dermatology and 2 months in Gastroenterology)
The Leeds Centre for Dermatology at Chapel Allerton Hospital consists of Inpatients located on C2 which is shared with Rheumatology and Out-patients with consulting rooms and facilities for Day Surgery, Laser treatments, Phototherapy, Day treatment, leg dressings and Patch testing. Further subspecialties included Moh's micrographic surgery, Paediatric Dermatology, Connective tissue disorders, and male and female genital dermatoses.
The Foundation trainee will primarily have responsibility for in-patients on ward C2 working in close collaboration with the ST2 grade and the Specialist registrar allocated on a rotational basis to the ward.
Learning opportunities: Training will be largely clinically based on the ward and in out-patients. There are regular academic activities on Friday afternoons including in rotation, Journal club, Consultant corners, Seminars, lectures, case presentation and discussions, clinico-path meetings and audit.
Please note that while we will support training opportunities in dermatology the commitment of the general medical on call will impact on this somewhat.

Duties will include history, examination, formulation of diagnostic and treatment plans. The trainee will be responsible for record keeping and communication and liaison with senior medical staff, other specialties, patients and relatives, diagnostic and therapeutic services, nursing and administration staff. There will be some requirement to assist in the investigation and management of patients in the out-patient setting and on the Day Case Unit.
