Department	 The Surgical unit at Pinderfields is a busy district general hospital unit offering a wide range of experience to trainees. It has an excellent track record of clinical and educational supervision. 6x Consultants, 4x SpR, 2x FY1, 1x FY2, 1x CT
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	In addition to the ward based clinical work there is a weekly colorectal education meeting where you will be encouraged to present cases and audits. There is also a weekly colorectal MDT and a weekly GI x-ray meeting that you can attend.
Where the placement is based	Pinderfields Hospital
Main duties of the placement	As a Foundation Year 1 doctor in Colorectal surgery (4 month post) you will be based at Pinderfields Hospital and provide ward support for elective and acute colorectal patients primarily on wards 32A and 33.
Typical working pattern in this placement	When on call you will provide support to the General Surgeons, the Vascular Surgeons and the Urology surgeons. This will provide you with a broad based surgical experience. The on call is a full shift system 1:12 with one week fixed annual leave and at least one operative week which allows you the opportunity to attend, vascular, breast, urology and colorectal operating theatres.
