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Main duties of the placement	The post holder's primary responsibility is the day-to-day-care of ward patients under the care of the Consultants in his/her team. The incumbent will receive instruction in procedures and help with management from senior colleagues. He/she will be expected to know the patients in detail and to present them on ward rounds.  The duties of the post include examining and writing up outpatient and in-patient emergency cases with responsibility for organising investigation.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Participation in a full shift working pattern with FY1 colleagues. Participation in ward rounds and the daily management of acute and elective inpatient care.
