<p>Main duties of the placement</p>	<p>The duties of the post include examining and writing up outpatient and in-patient emergency cases with responsibility for special investigation and obtaining blood and other samples. There is a phlebotomy service in operation and clinical support workers are employed by the Trust. The duties also include assisting and performing minor procedures and operations under supervision, with emergency duties.</p> <p>The post holder's primary responsibility is the day-to-day care of surgical ward patients under the care of the Consultants in his/her team. The incumbent will receive instruction in procedures and help with management from senior colleagues. He/she will be expected to know the patients in detail and to present them on ward rounds.</p>
<p>Typical working pattern in this placement</p>	<p>Participation in a full shift working pattern with FY1 colleagues. Participation in ward rounds and the daily management of acute and elective in-patient care.</p>
