Main duties of the placement	<p>The current duties include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Business Ward Round every weekday morning for both Cardiac and Thoracic patients along with a Consultant, a Registrar and Nurse practitioners</li> <li>- A board round at 15:30hrs to review all investigations for the day and implement decisions made</li> <li>- Attendance at Theatre and/or Cardiac ICU</li> <li>- Clinics to assess both New and Follow-up patients</li> <li>- Pre-admission clinics</li> <li>- As part of learning opportunities, attend Aortic MDT on alternative Tuesdays at 2pm; Complex MDT every Monday at 8:15am followed by TAVI MDT after depending on your posting for that day. Also a combined Cardiology/Cardiac Surgery MDT every Wednesday at 12:30 lunchtime</li> <li>- The F2 and Core Trainee's work a Full-Shift (1:5) with prospective cover.</li> </ul>
