Placement	Clinical Chemistry and Metabolic Medicine
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Clinical work in specialist metabolic clinics (Lipids, Metabolic Bone, Inherited Metabolic Disease). Laboratory work, if desired. Shadowing of Duty Biochemist, progressing to scrutiny, commenting and authorisation of clinical reports. Audit or research project usually completed during post.
Where the placement is based	NGH and RHH, Sheffield. Opportunity to spend time in Clinical Chemistry and relevant clinics at SCH if F2 wishes.
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Clinical supervisor Dr Godfrey Gillett. Educational supervisor also Dr Godfrey Gillett if F2 starts rotation in this placement.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Core hours only (M-F, 09-17), no on-call commitment. The rotations are 3 x 4 month rotations between various specialties.
