Department	Practices approved for F2 training in South Yorkshire offer a full range of primary health care services to their patients in a wide variety of settings.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The F2 will be attached to a single practice within South Yorkshire for the duration of the 4-month post and will be expected to integrate fully into the practice team. The F2 will undertake surgeries, clinics, visits and administrative duties as appropriate to his/her level of competency. Debriefing sessions will take place after surgeries, and formal teaching sessions will occur weekly, usually on a 1 to 1 basis with the supervising trainer. There will also be the opportunity to negotiate day release to another health care area in order to pursue a personal medical education objective.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The F2 will not undertake on-call or out of hours work during this placement.
