Placement	Genitourinary Medicine (RHH)
Department	The F2 post currently makes up one of the 5 SHO posts within the Department of GU medicine, along with GP and core medical training posts. The majority of the working week takes place in the outpatient setting, with in addition a commitment to contribute to the Specialised Medicine and Hospital at Night oncall rotas.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	There are opportunities to experience specialist services, including HIV clinics and sexual health promotion activities, and, with the ongoing integration of GUM and contraceptive units, it is possible that the delivery of a wide range of contraceptive methods will be incorporated into routine day-to-day practice.
Main duties of the placement	 Undertaking unselected routine GUM outpatient clinics and administrative duties under the supervision of the sexual health service consultant body as an integral part of the multidisciplinary sexual health team. This includes one evening clinic until 7.00pm per week. Managing the abnormal results of GU investigations both within the electronic patient record and with patients. SHO on-call duties at the Hallamshire Hospital, including the management of inpatients on the Haematology, Neurology, Infectious Diseases, Rheumatology and Dermatology wards. Attending GU postgraduate meetings and teaching, and contributing to the departmental journal club.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The rotations are 3 x 4 month rotations between various specialties.
