Placement	Geriatric Medicine (Sheffield teaching Hospitals) Our wards are based at the Northern General Hospital (NGH) and Royal Hallamshire Hospital (RHH)
Department	The post involves working on a Geriatric Medicine ward within a team that provides care for between 28 and 32 patients. Each ward has a different sub-specialty interest within Geriatrics. Most teams have an F1 doctor, another SHO equivalent doctor (VTS/CMT) and an SpR. Most posts include the opportunity to attend clinic. On call activity is for all specialties within General Medicine. Ward duties include supervision of the F1, teaching medical students and writing electronic discharge summaries prior to patients leaving hospital and working with colleagues and the MDT to progress patient care.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The rotations are 3 x 4 month rotations between various specialties.
