Grade	F2
Placement	Haematology (RHH)
Department	The Haematology department is a large tertiary unit providing the whole range of services to patients with blood malignancies (myeloma, leukaemia, lymphoma) including stem cell transplantation. There is a regional haemophilia centre and a large day ward facility. The F2 will be involved with the inpatient care of patients with these diseases but will also have the opportunity to attend outpatients and the weekly laboratory teaching sessions. F2's will participate on the Hospital at Night rota.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The rotations are 3 x 4 month rotations between various specialties.
