Placement	Respiratory Medicine (NGH)
Department	The Respiratory Directorate admits patients with a wide range of respiratory and general medical conditions including Asthma, Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease, Cystic Fibrosis, Interstitial Lung Disease, Sleep disorders, Lung Cancer, Tuberculosis and lung infection. We host regional units for Pulmonary Vascular Disease and Cystic fibrosis.
	Respiratory patients are admitted to Brearley $1 - 4$ at Northern General Hospital, cystic fibrosis patients to the dedicated CF ward at NGH and pulmonary hypertension patients to M2 at the Royal Hallamshire Hospital. There is a physiology unit and specialist respiratory outpatient clinics in the Brearley outpatients department at NGH.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The F2 post is based at the Pulmonary Vascular Disease Unit, Royal Hallamshire Hospital with on-call commitments to the Northern General Hospital. Daily ward duties involve the care of patients with pulmonary hypertension under from supervision the specialist registrar and consultant colleagues. Ward duties involve care for both emergency and elective admissions. Educational opportunities include the weekly specialist grand round, weekly radiology meeting and attendance to both clinic and cardiac catheter lists. In addition there is opportunity to undertake Audit.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The rotations are 3 x 4 month rotations between various specialties.
