Department	The Orthopaedic Department provide elective and 24-hour emergency orthopaedic services for both Sheffield and surrounding districts. The Department has a dedicated fracture clinic, separate Orthopaedic clinic and a theatre complex, all of which have laminar flow facility. There is a dedicated trauma theatre within the complex for treatment of emergency admissions.
	There are currently thirty-three Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeons. Each subspecialty team has a Specialty Registrar and either a F2 House Officer or F1 House Officer. There are also Core trainees, GPVTS and junior clinical fellows working within the department.

Weekly teaching on the Orthopaedic management of common fractures and dislocations. Elective and trauma theatres Fracture clinics and elective clinics You are welcome to attend any of the clinic or theatre sessions once the ward jobs have been completed Participation in the Orthopaedic full shift rota with prospective cover.
