Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	All paediatric consultants have completed Educational supervision training and trainees are allocated an appropriate supervisor at the start of each rotation by the paediatric college tutor.
Main duties of the placement	Clerking, examining and admitting children from the childrens assessment unit; instigating investigations; contributing to consultant led ward rounds and ward/assessment unit discharges. Working alongside Paediatric Specialist Trainee middle grades and first on call FY2/VTS/ Paediatric ST1-3 trainees. Team working with nurses, therapists to ensure patient-centred approach to care
Typical working pattern in this placement	FY1 trainees are not expected to carry the crash bleep. but work 1 long day per week (08.30 -21.00) and one weekend in 4 (Friday 08.30 -21.00 & Saturday/Sunday 08.30 – 17.00). They are not rota'd to work night shifts.
