When to apply for CoS

- You will be contacted by HEE National Overseas Sponsorship Team via email.
- You will be provided log in details to the Overseas Sponsorship Portal.
- Where you need to complete all the information required for HEE to issue you with a CoS.

What documents do I need to apply for CoS

- Passport
- Current visa/BRP
- Pay slip/NIN proof
- Copy of medical degree certificate
- Evidence of GMC registration
- Offer letter or Oriel email for your post

How long it will take for my CoS to arrive

- You can only request CoS 3 months prior to your start date.
- Priority Order:
- ✓ Expiry dates of current BRPs
- ✓ Out of country applications
- ✓ New applicants to HEE
- ✓ Student switching to Tier 2 / Skilled Worker
- ✓ Extensions of Tier 2 / Skilled Worker of those already sponsored by HEE

Other documents for visa application

- Criminal record certificate: if applying from outside UK
- Evidence of funds

Tier 5: Need to go to your home country

Tier 2 Visa you can apply from UK



Tier 2 Reporting Form

Notify HEE sponsorship team within 5 working days of change:

- Start date different from that mentioned in CoS
- Change in Immigration status
- Finished training earlier than expected
- IDT/LTFT/ILR approved
- Change of contact information
- Out Of Programme (OOP) application is approved
- Going on Maternity/Adoption/long term sick (>1month)
- Taking authorised unpaid leave
- Changed Speciality/resigned training
