FRCP Requirements

Complete Complex treatments and clinical activity logs - activity should include :

- Twelve indirect restorations (e.g. crowns, inlays, onlays). To include at least one of each type, if possible
- Two bridges. To include one conventional bridge, if possible
- Twelve acrylic prostheses
- Two Co-Cr prostheses
- Twelve endodontic cases to include both single-rooted (incisors and/or canines) and multi-rooted endodontic cases (molars and/or premolars) (x4 molar endodontics procedures are recommended)
- Four extractions of special difficulty (which may involve bone removal and/or flaps): one undertaken as SLE (DOP or mini-CEX) with ES,

Evidence to support EPAs

- 1. Sufficient depth and breadth of clinical experience as indication by FRCP clinical experience recommendations.
- 2. Protected learning time covering expected outcomes for EPAs
- 3. FD reflection covering experience gained to support EPAs
- 4. Developing clinical teacher SLE linked to EPA 9 (where relevant)
- 5. DENTL SLE linked to EPA 6,7,8,9 (where relevant)
- 6. DtCT SLE linked to EPA 6 and 9 (where relevant)
- 7. Significant Events
- 8. Quality improvement audits/projects (linked to EPA 8)

Portfolio Evidence

1. Supervised Learning Events

A minimum of 24 SLE's should be available on the portfolio at FRCP, the SLE's should provide sufficient evidence that each clinical EPA has sufficient evidence to allow the ES to confirm the level of enstrustment and to provide confidence to the FRCP panel that this evidence supports satisfactory completion of DFT.

2. Learning needs

These should all be reviewed and if indicated signed off as complete, any unsigned off learning needs that the FRCP panel consider essential to confirm the indicated entrustment level could mean completion of DFT is delayed.

3. Clinical Experience Logs and UDAs

Clinical experience logs should be completed for July, prior to FRCP panel days, this is to ensure all relevant clinical experience has been captured in the portfolio.

The BSA Compass report should be uploaded to the portfolio to evidence UDA activity achieved, by FRCP it is expected this will be above 1400 UDAs, <u>if</u> activity is significantly below this then the FD should provide a reflection to indicate the reason behind this.

4. ES FRCP report and FD comments

This report should be completed jointly, with your Educational Supervisor(s), with your own comments; without this evidence FRCP panels will be unable to reach a decision on completion of DFT.

5. IRCP recommendations

Please review IRCP panel reports and ensure any recommendations are met or if not, an explanation is provided.
