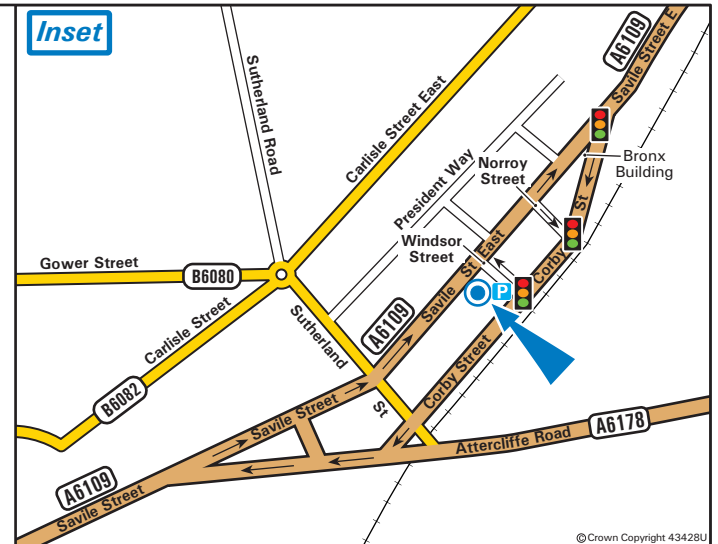

From the M1 (Northbound)

- Leave the M1 at Junction 34 (signed A6178, Sheffield (Meadowhall), Rotherham).
- At the roundabout take the 3rd exit (signed Rotherham (Kimberworth), A631 (A6109), Leeds, M1 North) - travel along the lower deck of the viaduct.
- At the end of the viaduct, take the 1st exit off the roundabout (signed A6109, Sheffield (Centre), Brightside, Don Valley Stadium).
- Keep in right hand lane and bear right following A6109.
- At Brightside (approx 1.5 miles) continue straight on at traffic lights onto Brightside Way - dual carriageway (Royal Mail building on your right).
- Road becomes single carriageway after traffic lights to pass under "Ferodo" railway bridge.
- When road becomes one-way system (with "Bronx" building on your right) move into right hand lane.
- Bear right to turn into Windsor Street at 2nd traffic lights (signed M1, M18, President Park).
- You have arrived - Don Valley House and free car park entrance is now on your left.

From the M1 (Southbound)

- Leave the M1 at Junction 34 (signed A6109, Sheffield (Meadowhall), Rotherham).
- At the roundabout take the 4th exit (signed A6109, Sheffield (Centre), Brightside, Don Valley Stadium).
- Keep in right hand lane and bear right following A6109.
- At Brightside (approx 1.5 miles) continue straight on at traffic lights onto Brightside Way - dual carriageway (Royal Mail building on your right).
- Road becomes single carriageway after traffic lights to pass under "Ferodo" railway bridge.
- When road becomes one-way system (with "Bronx" building on your right) move into right hand lane.
- Bear right to turn into Windsor Street at 2nd traffic lights (signed M1, M18, President Park).
- You have arrived - Don Valley House and free car park entrance is now on your left.

By Train
