The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Assessment and management of clients with suspected first episode psychosis. Role within team in undertaking some physical health assessments and venepuncture Opportunity to observe mental health act and crisis assessments Triaging and developing skills in both written and verbal communication Audit/service evaluation Attendance at reflective practice and team development sessions
Where the placement is based	The Limbrick centre, Hillsborough, Sheffield
Educational and Clinical Supervisor(s) for the placement	Clinical supervisor – Dr Priya Thaker Educational Supervisor (for the September starter only) will be Dr Thaker. The other two doctors will have Ed supervisors already in place as directed.
Main duties of the placement	F1 doctor will predominantly based within the assessment sub-team of the service working closely with leadership and nursing colleagues. Doctor will work towards independent assessments under supervision and will undertake joint assessments with staff. This may include home/ward based visits and working with staff across the trust. Attendance and discussion at MDT.

	Role in undertaking physical health review and audit alongside staff. Opportunity to undertake assessments and observe work with our at risk mental state sub-team as well as liaising with three consultants and a team of junior medics within the service.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Timetable can be pro rata or adjusted as needed. Flexibility within job to attend areas of interest within team/service as well as mandatory days/teaching Monday – clinical work, huddle pm Tuesday – clinical work, Consultant MDT 10.30, huddle pm Wednesday – CPD (am), clinical work, huddle pm Thursday – clinical work, Teaching 1-2, team development sessions, huddle pm Friday – supervision 9.15-10.15, huddle pm, Admin Assessment team meeting monthly, SDT day 1 day per month – tba in supervision
