Department	The post is based in Stanage Ward, where there is one Consultant with inpatient responsibilities, one ST, one F2 and one F1. There are 18 inpatient beds.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	To be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Perform full psychiatric assessments of patients, including history and mental state examination on culturally diverse patients; to construct formulations that include relevant differential diagnoses, and to propose comprehensive care plans 2. Assess and document patients' potential for self-harm or harm to others 3. Document accurately, briefly and clearly all relevant aspects of patients' care 4. Communicate effectively with patients, carers and colleagues, working in a multidisciplinary team environment 5. Develop organisational skills, including managing time 6. Perform an audit 7. Learn about clinical governance basics 8. Develop teaching skills 9. Develop appropriate professional behaviours.
