STC update - Jan 23

Faculty tutors – Welcome to Susie Robinson who is now FT for Rotherham and to Dr Selin Kabadayi who will take over at FT for Pinderfields from February. Thank you to Dr Lynch and Dr Sloan for all their work as FTs over the years

SSY update - There are a number of trainees in the region who have either undertaken or are currently doing an SSY. Education, research and echo have been undertaken successfully. An agreement with NW for ECMO has been finalised. A hepatology/transplant SSY is being formulated in Leeds. Trainees should note it takes approximately one year to arrange an SSY that is not already approved by FICM. Other ideas that could be considered include: palliative care, home ventilation

Resp/ICM training – The STC panel acknowledged the issues facing dual respiratory trainees as now there is an expectation tot ripple accredit. There are plans in place to assist these trainees to enable them to complete all the required competencies

Stage 3 HiLLOs – There remains a requirement in stage 3 to demonstrate continued maintenance of capability for paediatrics, cardiac and neurocritical care. This could be demonstrated by an SLE, teaching or course. If a trainee felt that more time in the specialty area is required, a "top up" can be arranged via Dr Sandhu

ARCP – It was acknowledged that Winter ARCP dates are often close to holidays and it can be challenging to get both ES and FT to complete ESSR requirements in time. It was reminded that trainees get three months notice before ARCP and that preparation is key. Use of the ARCP checklist continues to be recommended in order not to miss uploading vital evidence. As we adjust to the new portfolio, comments from the ARCP panel was that the in built logbook is not as effective as other available logbooks, such as the Sunderland logbook, and encouraged trainees to use this if possible

ARCP dates (Summer) – West 22/6/23, East 28/6/23, South 7/7/23

Education update - The FFIVA course is due to run for the March sitting of the OSCE/SOE. At the last regional teaching there was a session on SBA's as the written exam is now entirely in SBA format. The feedback for this has been extremely positive and there is a plan for this to continue in future regional teaching sessions. For trainees who are organising regional teaching, please get in touch with Cat Anderson who can assist with this

ICM conference 2023 – Funding has now been approved for this year's Yorkshire conference. Again it will be free to ICM trainees, with a small cost for non-ICM trainees and consultants
