7	Primary Care Element	There will be some sessions based in Primary Care facilities, working with a Specialist Oral Surgeon in the Public Dental Service. No Provider/NHS list number is necessary for this.

8	<b>Description of the training post</b>	<p>The Oral Surgery service in Edinburgh is provided by a team of four whole time Consultants and 1.2 WTE Specialist Oral Surgeons. Outpatient and surgical lists, including LA, LA/Sedation, GA day case, are routinely undertaken at the Edinburgh Dental Institute, The Royal Hospital for Children and Young Adults and Roodlands General Hospital, Haddington.</p> <p>Oral Surgery training will be delivered over a three-year full time programme. This should lead to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Membership of a Royal College (e.g. M Oral Surgery) and a CCST</li> <li>• Entry onto the specialist list in Oral Surgery</li> <li>• Eligibility to practice as a specialist</li> </ul> <p>The Department has a history of postgraduate training at a number of levels. This includes MClin Dent and DClin Dent programmes in Oral Surgery.</p> <p>Multidisciplinary clinics are held regularly with Orthodontic, Restorative and Paediatric colleagues. This includes implant placement and hypodontia.</p> <p>There will be no on-call commitment with this post. This post will be suitable for anyone wishing to pursue a career in Oral Surgery.</p> <p>Trainee will be exposed to the specialist educational programme organised locally in Edinburgh with education days also taking place for Specialty Registrars in Scotland.</p> <p><b><u>Management of healthcare delivery</u></b></p> <p>Trainee will be expected to attend the monthly departmental and clinical audit meetings.</p> <p><b><u>Audit, research, critical appraisal</u></b></p> <p>Trainee will have the responsibility for organising Journal Clubs and will be expected to undertake clinical audit.</p>
