Outpatient and surgical lists, including LA, LA/Sedation, GA day case, are routinely undertaken at the Edinburgh Dental Institute, The Royal Hospital for Children and Young Adults and Roodlands General Hospital, Haddington.  Oral Surgery training will be delivered over a three-year full time programme. This should lead to:  • Membership of a Royal College (e.g. M Oral Surgery) and a CCST  • Entry onto the specialist list in Oral Surgery  • Eligibility to practice as a specialist  The Department has a history of postgraduate training at a number of levels. This includes MClin Dent and DClin Dent programmes in Oral Surgery.  Multidisciplinary clinics are held regularly with Orthodontic, Restorative and Paediatric colleagues. This includes implant placement and hypodontia.  There will be no on-call commitment with this post. This post will be suitable for anyone wishing to pursue a career in Oral Surgery.  Trainee will be exposed to the specialist educational programme organised locally in Edinburgh with education days also taking place for Specialty Registrars in Scotland.  Management of healthcare delivery Trainee will be expected to attend the monthly departmental and clinical audit meetings.
