experience and ability.

The Units also manages all acute maxillofacial trauma including soft tissue injury and other orofacial emergencies. This post provides an opportunity for 1 in 5 (Bradford) or 1 in 7 (Hull) second on-call commitment to develop trauma management skills.

Sheffield

The training is based primarily at The Charles Clifford Dental Hospital. Out patients work is undertaken at the Charles Clifford Hospital, Royal Hallamshire Hospital, University of Sheffield Dental Practice Unit and Sheffield Children's Hospital. Special interests for trainees will include nerve repair and implant surgery training as well as exposure to management of complex pain symptoms such as trigeminal neuralgia. There will be the opportunity to engage in research projects and develop academic skills. Additional work duties may be required at additional trust sites as parts of Sheffield Teaching Hospitals such as Jessops, Weston Park, and Northern General Hospitals. Occasional work placement may be required at satellite community sites.

Bradford

Educational facilities

The postgraduate Centre is located in Field House along with the Medical Library. There is also a clinical skills lab and simulation suite to which the successful candidate will have access. There is a designated trainee common room and a well-stocked library in the maxillofacial unit at St Luke's Hospital. Trainees will have access to a computer as well as administrative support for their work.

Hull Royal Infirmary

Educational facilities

The medical education centre and library (linked with Hull York Medical School) are located on the Hull Royal Infirmary site. There is also a clinical skills lab and simulation suite to which the successful candidate will have access.

There is a shared trainees office within the department for use by the successful candidate on a "hot desk" basis. They will have access to a telephone and PC. There will be administrative support available for their work.

Sheffield Hospitals

Educational facilities

The trainee will benefit from excellent academic facilities and access to the health and science library located at the Medical School of Sheffield University. Trainees have a shared space that is located on the first floor of the dental school side.

Educational supervision

The Training Programme Director (TPD) for Oral Surgery is Miss Divya Keshani who will manage the overall training. Additionally, each StR is assigned to an Educational Supervisor who will provide guidance in his/her training and career and carry out regular appraisals.
