<p>Main duties of the placement</p>	<p>Post holder will have the unique opportunity of being first on-call to review all paediatric emergencies.</p> <p>The post holder will gain experience in Paediatric Intravenous Cannulation, Intravenous fluid management, drug prescriptions in Paediatrics and Immediate discharge letters.</p> <p>There is a weekly teaching programme in the department. The post holder will have opportunity to attend outpatient clinic sessions. You will gain experience in Critical Care Management of paediatric patients.</p>
<p>Typical working pattern in this placement</p>	<p>Ward rounds, clinics, Participate in a full shift rota with paediatric trainees. Attending paediatric clinics.</p> <p>Out of hours work could be in any other specialty and will be reflected in your work schedule with adequate notice</p>
