	Leave the M1 at Junction 34 (signed A6178, Sheffield (Meadowhall), Rotherham).
	At the roundabout take the 3 rd exit (signed Rotherham (Kimberworth), A631 (A6109), Leeds, M1
	North) – travel along the lower deck of the viaduct.
	At the end of the viaduct, take the 1st exit off the roundabout (signed A6109, Sheffield (Centre),
	Brightside, Don Valley Stadium).
	Keep in right hand land and bear right following A6109.
	At Brightside (approx. 1.5 miles) continue straight on at traffic lights onto Brightside Way - dual
	carriageway (Royal Mail building on your right).
	Road become single carriageway after traffic lights to pass under "Ferodo" railway bridge.
	When road becomes one-way system (with "Bronx" building on your right) move into right hand
	lane.
	Bear right to turn into Windsor Street at 2 nd traffic lights (signed M1, M18, President Park).
	You have arrived – Don Valley House and free car park entrance is now on your left.
