## Supporting ST3+ Trainees in South Yorkshire

**A number of bursaries are available by competition annually to enable trainees to present work overseas and in the UK. Funding is up to £1000 for an international oral presentation, £500 for an international poster and £250 for a UK oral presentation.**



The fund was set up in memory of Sir Ernest Finch, a highly respected Surgeon, and a leader in Medical Education in the University of Sheffield Medical School.

The purpose of the fund is to support the exchange of medical and surgical learning and skills into and out of Sheffield.

How the fund has helped:

Michael Paddock, Consultant Radiologist at Barnsley NHS Foundation Trust, applied to the fund when he was a trainee. He presented at the International Paediatric Radiology Congress, the largest congress on paediatric imaging worldwide which takes place every 5 years. Michael was awarded the Young Researcher Award for Best Scientific Oral Presentation at the meeting and was recently awarded the Inaugural Royal College of Radiologists (RCR) Outstanding Clinical Radiology Research award, which he believes the Sir Ernest Finch Fellowship contributed to.
