

## **STARS - Simulation Training for Acute and Routine Scenarios**

*An introduction to NHS hospital medicine, human factors, and communication skills*

You have been identified as a GP Trainee who has not had much NHS experience and are due to go into your first Trust post.

We have arranged some clinical simulation which will be held face to face **in Hull**. This will give you the ability to practice ward based clinical skills in a safe environment, with structured feedback to help support you develop. Your allocated date has been identified in your initial letter from the GP Training Support Team, and should take place within your Enhanced Support Period (the first two weeks of your first Trust post).

A finalised agenda and further details will be sent to you closer to the date.

Your Trust has been made aware of this training, and your allocated date, and should release you to attend this. However, if you are asked to book study leave please do this as early as possible, since the allocated date will be very early in your training. Do not wait until you have started in post before booking study leave, but try to do this in advance.

Details of how to book study leave will be different from Trust to Trust –in most Trusts you will need to inform your rota coordinator and complete a study leave application.
