

Trauma & Orthopaedics ST3 National Recruitment COVID-19 Contingency Arrangements

In response to the unprecedented COVID-19 outbreak and the subsequent guidance from the government a difficult decision to cancel all face to face specialty recruitment was made.

A Task and Finish Group was formed to agree general principles for the appointment of doctors to specialty training programmes for August 2020. This Group consisted of senior clinical representatives from across the four nations, junior doctor representatives from the British Medical Association Junior Doctors Committee (BMA JDC) and Academy of Medical Royal Colleges (AoMRC) trainees' committee, supported by the Medical and Dental Recruitment and Selection (MDRS) Team.

The Task and Finish Group agreed that clinician involvement should be reduced to an absolute minimum, consequently Trauma & Orthopaedics ST3 recruitment will proceed without an interview. Self-assessment will therefore be used as the sole method of ranking the eligible applicants and offering posts to a full ST3 training programme in this round. Some LATs may still be offered in the participating Devolved Nations in line with the standard recruitment process.

The Task and Finish Group has confirmed that we cannot accept additional evidence and applicants are unable to amend their self-assessment scores after submission. Your score and ranking will be calculated using the answers you submitted when you completed your self-assessment. This is to ensure that the scores submitted and used for ranking are all representative of the same time period and do not disadvantage applicants whose experience has been severely disrupted due to the current pandemic.

Applicants who realise that they have <u>over scored</u> their self-assessment must email the Trauma & Orthopaedics ST3 national recruitment office at <u>torec.yh@hee.nhs.uk</u> as soon as possible and by no later than 14th April 2020.
